



## LIFEPORT RECEIVES APPROVAL FOR AW139 SYSTEM

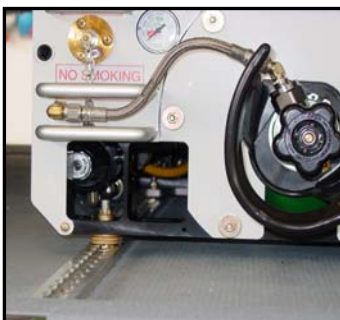
LifePort of Woodland, WA USA has obtained Supplemental Type Certificate (STC) approval for a multi-mission medevac system in the Agusta Westland AW139 helicopter. The system was delivered to the Irish Air Corps and the Government of Estonia as part of a contract with the aircraft manufacturer.

The advanced life support (ALS) modular system is designed for installation or removal from the aircraft in under fifteen minutes after initial modification. The system includes a 16G tracking and pivoting MedDeck that enables patient loading from outside, either from the right or left-side door. The system is delivered with FAA STC's and can include EASA approval for international operators.



### Highlights for the AW139 configuration include:

- Lightweight, low-profile, self-contained, modular air ambulance system
- System base unit contains 3500 liter oxygen cylinder (approximately 3.8 hours of oxygen at 15 LPM), 28VDC Thomas vacuum and compressed air systems and 115 or 230VAC electrical inverter
- Designed to mount to existing aircraft floor without the need for tools
- Equipped with a 16G MedDeck for easy patient loading and unloading
- Ideal for dedicated programs or for multi-mission operators
